

## 3. FRAMEWORK (1/2)

## 3. FRAMEWORK (2/2)



25 November 2021

#### Article 1:

The joint Committee meets at least once per trimester, on LFS and DSS Supervisors' initiative.

#### Article 2:

The LFS and DSS Supervisors set the dates and times of meetings. They send the invitations, proposal of agenda and preparatory documents 10 days in advance. All questions are to be sent at least one week before the meeting. The Supervisors send the meeting minutes.

#### Article 3:

The chairs persons from DSS and LFS are jointly conducting the Committee.

The Committee can only take place if enough members are present at the beginning of the meeting: at least one parent and one pupil from LFS side, as well as one parent from DSS side. In case the number of required parents or pupils is not reached, the meeting is postponed within 8 and 15 days. If the number is not reached then, the meeting is adjourned until the following trimester.

#### Article 4:

The Committee meets within 75 min. time. If questions cannot be addressed within that frame, they can be reported to the next meeting.


#### 4) Canteen KPI

The change of menu is not possible during the period for which it has been validated. There is only one difference it is for the set menu, there are 2 proteins for the Germans and one meat for the French.













## 1) Action plans

- For environmental protection, new colorful plastic cups are put everywhere in the canteen (beside water machines and service lines etc.) so that people can get them more easily.
- If the food contains any potentially allergenic element such as lactose, bean or gluten, an icon is highlighted under the description of the dishes on the daily menu. Colorful icons are also used to differentiate the meats (beef, pork, chicken, duck, fish etc).
- In Trattoria service line, vegetables are now provided as well to make students eat in a healthier way.
- Different sizes of veggie/tomato/fruit cup are available now according to the comments received last year. Students and staff can choose the size (big or small) that they want.
- Posters are posted at many places in the canteen to remind students and staff that starch and
  vegetables can be refilled freely. But people are invited to finish the plate before the free refill to
  avoid any wastage.

Is it possible to have sauce on the side of the meat, to let child decide if they need sauce or not This is ok, it will be implemented soon

Regarding the rest of the food, is it possible for Chartwells to sell at a competitive price? This may attrack staff to purchase and for Chartwells it will be less food to throw away.

Currently Chartwells propose 2 prices depending of the food: 15 RMB and 19 RMB. Chartwells is open to discuss this topic.

#### Time to eat is not enough

Time depends on schools, we need more details, which level are we talking about.

#### Portions are too small

There is a grammage to be respected by Chartwells, and we do audits to verify. We can confirm that the supplier complies with the requirement of the contract. In any case, if the students are still hungry, they have the possibility to refill.
