



School Supplies 2025-2026 Middle/High School – Qingpu and Yangpu campuses

The school will provide the following school supplies:

Notebooks, Chinese notebooks, binders, single and double writing paper, as well as a file organizer depending on the level.

These supplies will be handed to students by teachers at the beginning of the year.

Middle and high school students will need to have the following supplies for the start of the school year:

A **pencil case** with materials: HB pencil, ballpoint pens, erasable blue Frixion pen with refills, Criterion (0.5 or 0.7mm), colored pencils, fine liners, glue, eraser, scissors, highlighters.

A fine black felt-tip pen (ink pen)

A minimum 20 cm ruler , a set square, a compass, a non-flexible protractor

Clear books

For students of all levels: 3 clear books of 30 transparent pockets

For first and final year students: 3 clear books of 60 transparent pockets

1 A4 flexible binder, 4 rings with colored dividers

For all levels, especially high school, we recommend purchasing two large binders, dividers, and transparent pockets.

A block of **graph paper** (from 4^e)

A 100% cotton long-sleeve white **lab gown** for students in grades 6^e to 3^e and for students specializing in visual arts (Spécialité Arts for 1^{re} and Terminale students only).

A tracksuit or shorts, a tee shirt and a pair of sneakers suitable for sport + a second pair for the gym A change of clothes

Swimsuit, goggles, cap, towel and shower products for the pool.

CALCULATOR:

- For middle school students: a scientific calculator.
- For students entering the second year of high school, it is recommended to purchase the Numworks calculator.
- For first and final year students: a programmable calculator with the exam mode function (TI-83 premium CE Texas Instruments or Casio Graph 90+E or Numworks).

Students who already have a calculator with exam mode can keep it.

A headset or headphones

A USB key of at least 8 GB

A Yamaha Soprano **recorder** (for students from 6^e to 3^e)

A roll of non-adhesive paper for covering books





<u>Advice for final year students</u> : purchase the BAC past papers as soon as they are published, i.e. in October/November.
